

Their intimate bond is strengthened by their participation in a burial circle, a traditional ritual that closes the circle of life. As their lives are slowly transformed, each woman finds unexpected strength and resilience.

A native New Yorker, Bletter grew up hearing about her relatives in Israel and the sacrifices they made to live there. Inspired by their courage, Bletter moved with her family to an Israeli seaside village where she worked as a freelance journalist, reporting on untold stories behind headlines in the news.

In A Remarkable Kindness, Bletter intertwines her personal experiences into this stirring novel of sorrow and hope, of friendship and love, illuminating a mostly unknown ritual that underscores what it means to truly be alive.

Diana Bletter is a writer whose work has appeared in a wide variety of publications, including *The New York Times, The Wall Street Journal*, and *Commentary*. Her first book, *The Invisible Thread: A Portrait of Jewish American Women*, with photographs by Lori Grinker, was nominated for a National Jewish Book Award. A graduate of Cornell University, Diana has worked at a number of magazines and newspapers including *National Lampoon* and *The Southampton Press*. Diana grew up in Great Neck, New York, and now lives in a seaside village in northern Israel with her husband and children, where she is a member of a burial circle.
